On 12/16/2025 at approximately 1134 hours, Deputies responded to ██████████, Deltona in reference to an assault/battery involving a firearm.

Upon arrival Deputies made contact with ██████████ (V1) who advised the following:

████████ stated he was at home when he received a notification from his Ring camera's of motion outside the home. He looked at the camera's at residence function and witnessed a male later identified as ██████████ (S1) walking around vehicles within the driveway. ██████████ stated he knew ██████████ to be the husband of his roommate so he went outside to confront ██████████ to see what he needed. Upon making contact with ██████████, ██████████ state ██████████ claimed he was at the resident to retrieve the license plates from the vehicles due to them being in his name as he is currently going through a divorce with ██████████'s roommate. ██████████ stated the two began to argue about who the vehicles belonged too. As they exchanged words both parties exchanged threats towards each other before ██████████ said he began to walk back inside the residence. ██████████ stated ██████████ got into his truck and backed out of the driveway but continued to yell at him from the front seat of his vehicle. ██████████ stated ██████████ stated the two could take the argument into the street and fight if he wished, at which point ██████████ was parked sitting in his truck in front of the residence. ██████████ stated he obliged ██████████'s request to fight in the street and began approaching ██████████'s vehicle. Once at the edge of the property and road where ██████████ was parked, ██████████ stated ██████████ pulled out a large black handgun and pointed it right at his chest from within the vehicle. ██████████ stated this action put him in a well-founded fear for his life and he put his hands up in the air and backed away from ██████████. As he backed up away from ██████████, ██████████ stated ██████████ drove off from the residence. ██████████ provided Deputies with ██████████'s information and address.

████████ provided Deputies with a sworn written statement detailing the event in which he stated he wished to pursue criminal charges against ██████████

When asked if the Ring camera's at the residence were functional, ██████████ stated they were indeed active but did not record and he was only able to watch a live feed of the camera's at residence function. Deputies canvased surrounding neighboring homes in an attempt to gain video surveillance footage of the incident but were met with negative results.

While on scene Deputies made contact with a worker later identified as ██████████ (W1) at a nearby home located at ██████████, who advised the following:

█████████ stated while working in the garage he overheard a verbal argument coming from 1445, so he stepped out of the garage to see what was happening. ██████████ stated he observed a Red Chevy truck back out of the driveway fast before stopping in front of the residence and he overheard a loud argument. Shortly later he stated the Red Chevy sped off at a high rate of speed away from the home. ██████████ stated he did not witness any firearms and could not make out what the two men were arguing about.

Deputies responded to ██████████'s residence located at ██████████, Deltona.

Upon arrival, Deputies made contact with ██████████ who agreed to step out of the residence and speak with Deputies. Deputy Craddock read ██████████ his Miranda rights from an agency issued Miranda Warnings card at which time ██████████ stated he understood his rights and agreed to speak with Deputies on the matter.

█████████ stated he had gone to his soon to be ex-wife's home located at ██████████, Deltona in an attempt to retrieve the license plates registered under his name which were attached to the vehicle he and his wife bought together. ██████████ stated while at the home ██████████ came outside and began to argue with him over the ownership of the vehicle. ██████████ stated the argument went back and forth between the two as they traded remarks. ██████████ stated he became frustrated with the situation as ██████████ began to threaten him and become aggressive towards ██████████. ██████████ said ██████████ stated to him that the two could fight if he wished and ██████████ threw up both of his fists and stood in a fighting stance, at which point ██████████ stated he would not fight on the property, and they could fight in the street. ██████████ stated ██████████ began walking towards the front door of the residence, so he retreated to his vehicle to leave the residence. While backing out of the driveway, he explained ██████████ continued to verbally threaten him, ██████████ stated he stopped his vehicle due to ██████████ stating he would call the police. ██████████ stated he told ██████████ to call the police so the matter could be handled and while sitting in his vehicle ██████████ began to run towards ██████████. ██████████ stated ██████████ ran at him in an aggressive manner while grabbing at his waist, at which point ██████████ said he didn't know if ██████████ had a weapon or not, so he pulled out his Sig Sauer 9mm pistol from his right hip and placed it on his lap. ██████████ stated ██████████ made it to the driver's door of his vehicle and witnessed the firearm sitting on his lap.
