

AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

FROM SECTION 1
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On December 18, 2025, at approximately 1304 hours, Deputy Shaheen responded to [REDACTED], Astor, in reference to a missing person/suspicious incident. Upon arrival, Deputy Shaheen made contact with [REDACTED] (R1), who stated his wife, [REDACTED] (O2), left the residence at approximately 0900 hours to pick up medication from Walmart in DeLand and had not returned.

Deputy Shaheen conducted a check of law enforcement databases and camera systems, confirming [REDACTED] was in the area at approximately 1100 hours. Deputy Shaheen informed [REDACTED] of these findings, which appeared to anger him.

While speaking with [REDACTED] a neighbor from [REDACTED] knocked on the door and provided his phone for Deputy Shaheen to speak with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] (son in law of [REDACTED] contacted him and advised that he and his wife, [REDACTED], were taking [REDACTED] away from [REDACTED] because she had been trying to leave due to [REDACTED] being threatening. [REDACTED] further stated he would assist [REDACTED] if needed when he returned home at 1700 hours.

After relaying this information to [REDACTED] he became irate and stated he would do physical harm to [REDACTED] if he was present. [REDACTED] then stated, "If I had the strength to do what her brother did, I would." When asked to clarify that statement, [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED]'s brother shot himself in the head. Deputy Shaheen then asked [REDACTED] if he had any firearms, and [REDACTED] stated he had two—a Taurus revolver (serial # CS807975) and a Smith & Wesson revolver (serial # 9D75204)—next to the chair he was sitting in. [REDACTED] then began reaching for one of the firearms. Deputy Shaheen immediately secured [REDACTED]'s arm to prevent him from retrieving the weapon.

Deputy Shaheen then requested Deputy Vargas to respond as backup, and he arrived shortly thereafter.

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Deputy Shaheen secured both firearms and placed them out of [REDACTED]' reach for his safety. [REDACTED] became highly upset and belligerent when doing so. Deputy Shaheen tried to explain, based on statements and immediate access to firearms and having full capability to carry through with his actions, Deputy Shaheen feared for [REDACTED]' safety and well-being. [REDACTED] refused to comply with Deputy Shaheen' s protective custody request and concern.

Deputy Shaheen also advised [REDACTED] that his firearms would be placed into safekeeping and that a Risk Protection Order (RPO) would be filed, which he refused to listen and understand. The firearms were secured in Deputy Shaheen' s patrol vehicle.

Volusia County Fire Rescue was contacted for transport, which was completed without incident.

While following medical personnel to Halifax Hospital, I contacted [REDACTED] via phone. [REDACTED] stated they were helping [REDACTED] leave [REDACTED] because he had been "getting worse" and had threatened harm toward [REDACTED] and her family. [REDACTED] confirmed [REDACTED] was with them and stated they told [REDACTED] they were taking [REDACTED] to [REDACTED], but they were going to [REDACTED]. Barry expressed strong concern to not letting [REDACTED] know her whereabouts as he fears for her safety.

Once [REDACTED] was turned over to Halifax Hospital staff, Deputy Shaheen completed the necessary paperwork to file an RPO. [REDACTED] was provided with a case number reference to a firearm receipt. Both firearms were submitted into safekeeping pending the RPO. All ammunition and firearms were submitted into safekeeping.


