I, {full legal name} Cody Douglas Martin, in my position as {job title} Deputy Sheriff with the {name of law enforcement officer/agency} Volusia Sheriff's Office, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. {Name of Respondent} _____ poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

_____ had made homicidal statements stating he was going to kidnap and shoot his ex-roommate's girlfriend. Additionally, _____ sent the ex-rommate a video of him shooting a handgun in the air, but in the direction of his head after saying his goodbyes. *See continuation page for full report*
It should be noted, _____ refused to voluntarily surrender firearms and indicated he had over 300 firearms in his possession.

On 01/29/2026 at approximately 1845 hours, Deputy Martin responded to [REDACTED] in Deltona in reference to a mentally ill person.

Prior to arrival, it was reported by [REDACTED] (W1) that he had received several text messages this evening from [REDACTED] (S1). In these messages, [REDACTED] was inquiring about retrieving some of his belongings that were still at the residence which he had left there after moving out in November of 2025. [REDACTED] became disgruntled and expressed his discontent of [REDACTED] leaving his belongings at the residence. Although the text messages have no evidentiary significance, it led up to [REDACTED] calling [REDACTED] via the phone and telling him he was going to smash all his belongings and bring it down towards the curb to be discarded. [REDACTED] then told [REDACTED] that he knows where [REDACTED]'s girlfriend lives and he was going to go to her house to "kick the door in, kidnap her, and kill her by shooting her." Following that statement, [REDACTED] heard what he believed to be [REDACTED] "rack a gun," in an effort to instill fear in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] ultimately feared for the safety of his girlfriend who resides at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] contacted law enforcement due to the homicidal statements which were made to him but directed towards his girlfriend. [REDACTED] noted that approximately 2 weeks prior, [REDACTED] had sent him a video of himself saying "I just want y'all to understand I love you more than anything in this world, I will always love you more than anything in this world. I'm sorry for everything that's about to happen." [REDACTED] then brandished a silver handgun pointed in the air and stated, "I love you." [REDACTED] then fired the handgun in the air in the immediate direction of his head but did not hit his head. Afterwards, the video cut off. [REDACTED] advised he did not call law enforcement immediately when he received the video because a couple of [REDACTED]'s friends stated they were going to take care of him. [REDACTED] completed a sworn written statement on his involvement.

Deputy Martin requested Port Orange Police conduct a well being check on [REDACTED]'s girlfriend at their residence, who was contacted and was made aware of the incident simultaneously while in contact with [REDACTED]

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Upon arrival, deputies observed a male which they observed to be [REDACTED] from previous incidents in the front yard near his pickup truck. Deputies on scene created a perimeter around the residence and observed [REDACTED] go to his passenger side of his truck while the door was open. When [REDACTED] moved away from the truck, deputies converged on the residence and ordered [REDACTED] onto the ground at gunpoint and gained compliance from him. Once [REDACTED] was secured, Deputy Graham observed a black handgun in plain view placed on the passenger seat of the open pickup truck.

[REDACTED] was placed under protective custody under the baker act for suicidal ideations and homicidal ideations which were present on the present day of the incident and additionally weeks prior which went unreported until [REDACTED] called in.

[REDACTED] refused to voluntarily surrender his firearm under a risk protection order and advised he had several other firearms within his residence under his possession.

Due to the refusal of voluntary surrender, Deputy Martin will submit a risk protection order due to the videos and statements obtained.

Additionally, all videos were submitted into axon for evidentiary value.

[REDACTED] was transported to the Halifax Medical Center in Daytona Beach under the baker act without incident.
