Students must be able to qualify on the 48 round course to attend.

Pre-Requisites: All students must have successfully completed the General Instructor Techniques Course PRIOR to attending this course. And complete three years experience as a certified criminal justice officer.

Topics of instruction include: *Basic Recruit Firearms textbook changes *Firearms Instructor course changes *Basic recruit firearms proficiency evaluations, daylight and nigh-time qualification courses* Discretionary shooting *Active threat/Shooter drills

Students who cannot qualify cannot continue. A written exam is given with an 85% pass rate at the end of the course.

Students must bring the following:

- Body armor, eye & ear protection, water.
- 3 magazines, duty belt, flashlight, and hat.

Non-VSO personnel must bring 1,000 rounds pistol, 500 rounds pistol frangible, and 6 pistol dummy rounds
