

COURSE: This course is part of the CJSTC Advanced Training Program and is designed to cover the methods of case preparation and court presentation. Topics include maintaining case files, pre-trial discovery, depositions, plea bargaining, pre-trial conferences, court testimony-moot court, and post-conviction responsibilities. Instructor will utilize guest speakers including various judges and/or attorneys to present material from the "officer of the court" point of view. This course will benefit experienced investigators as well as less experienced officers.

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING: Note taking materials, textbook will be provided by The Academy.
