

### **COURSE:**

If you desire to become an instructor focused on teaching CJSTC curriculum for basic recruit and/or advanced/specialized training, this is the course for you. This participation-based FDLE certifying course is designed to prepare those who desire to teach in-service and basic law enforcement curriculum. Students will be instructed on proper teaching techniques, professionalism, and use of learning aids (PowerPoint®) to deliver effective instruction. Upon successful completion of the course, a required teaching internship must be completed by each student in order for FDLE to certify you as a General Instructor.
