

COURSE: This course is intended to prepare the Deputies to respond immediately to an active shooter incident. Deputies will learn the mental and technical aspects of a single officer response to an active assailant.

STUDENTS SHOULD BRING:

- Minimum three (3) magazines
- Full duty rig/holster AND vest (no Inside the waistband or concealed holsters)
- Flashlight AND weapon mounted light (if already affixed)
- Body Armor
- Full eye protection and full ear protection
- · Note taking material
- · Ammo will be provided

ATTIRE: Clothing: Normal duty uniform based on assignment, NO SHORTS.
(NO RED T-SHIRTS OR RED HATS ALLOWED)

NOTE:** Class will expose students to stress and moderate physical discomfort due to the dynamic nature of the drills and scenarios.**

- Psychological/Physiological Response
- Principles of Response
- The importance of Immediate Response
- Tactical Movement and Angles
- Live Fire and Practical Training Exercise
- Aftermath
