DAY ONE:

Classroom instruction focuses on leadership communication, professional presence, public speaking, presentation development, audience awareness, stakeholder communication, message clarity, delivery and responding to questions. Law enforcement examples, discussions and practical exercises help participants apply the concepts to situations they are likely to face as supervisors and command-level leaders.



DAY TWO:

Day Two moves participants from understanding communication principles to applying them in realistic leadership situations. Exercises may include executive briefings, community presentations, presentations to governing bodies or senior decision-makers, internal organizational presentations, impromptu speaking, stakeholder questions and selected recorded presentation exercises.
