According to did this exact thing about 1 year ago. stated does not have any mental illness but does have health problems and that his memory is not like it use to be.
provided Deputy Shaheen with a sworn written statement about the incident.
Deputy Gardner transported to Halifax Hospital, Daytona Beach for further treatment.
