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BWC RECORDING

On July 27th, 2026, at 0147 hours, Deputy Woodin responded to the [REDACTED] Fire Station 65, located at 2983 Howland Boulevard, [REDACTED] in reference to a possible civil issue. Upon arrival, Deputy Woodin contacted a juvenile, identified as [REDACTED] a minor (W1).

[REDACTED] who is sixteen, stated that he left home after he got into an argument with his parents. His mother had asked him what he perceived as an odd question which led to an argument and his parents confiscated his [REDACTED] phone. After [REDACTED] was sent to his room, he waited for his parents to go to sleep and then left. He subsequently walked to the fire station and asked for law enforcement assistance. [REDACTED] stated that the argument was only verbal.

[REDACTED] also mentioned to Deputy Woodin that he [REDACTED] as if there is no privacy inside the home as his mother has cameras in every room that video and audio record everything inside the home. He stated he even has one in his room and is not allowed to turn it off. Oftentimes he has to get changed in front of the camera and this makes him uncomfortable.

Deputy Woodin then proceeded to confirm that [REDACTED] had not been entered as missing and proceeded to provide him with a courtesy ride back to his residence. Prior to leaving, [REDACTED] stated that his mother has multiple issues and that [REDACTED] two weeks ago she grabbed a gun from his dad's car and pointed it at him during an argument. Based on this information, Deputy Woodin requested backup to investigate this allegation. While enroute to [REDACTED] home, his mother called in to report him missing.

Upon arrival at [REDACTED] home, Deputy Woodin contacted his mother, identified as [REDACTED] (S1), and his father identified as [REDACTED] (V1).

Deputy Dallas spoke with [REDACTED] who was not forthcoming with information regarding the allegation with the gun. At one point during the investigation, [REDACTED] had come to where Deputy Woodin and [REDACTED] were speaking and he heard her admit to some of the incident. Deputy Dallas then interviewed [REDACTED] again, at which point he advised that he and his wife got into a verbal argument over a text message that he received which his wife saw. The verbal argument ensued until [REDACTED] went and grabbed a gun from his vehicle. [REDACTED] then walked inside while holding the gun and went into the bedroom. [REDACTED] followed her and was able to take the gun away.

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_____ stated at no point did _____ point the gun at him or threaten him with it. _____ also confirmed that the argument was only verbal and never got physical in any way. _____ stated it was just him and _____ inside the bedroom when this incident occurred. _____ stated that the firearm in question is a handgun and that he keeps it locked up in a safe that only he has a code for.

Deputy Woodin interviewed _____ stated that she suffers from multiple mental illnesses, including anxiety, depression, OCD, PTSD, bipolar, and insomnia. She stated that she sees a therapist on a regular basis and keeps up with her medications. When asked about the incident with the firearm, she stated that her husband and her got into a verbal argument over personal _____ issues around the weekend of July 17th, 2026. _____ stated that this verbal argument ensued for a long time and culminated with her grabbing her husband's firearm from the vehicle in the garage and walking into her bedroom with it. _____ stated that she never pointed it at anyone or threatened anyone inside the home with the gun. _____ admitted that her sole intention with the firearm during this incident was to "take _____ out" or go out and harm someone _____. _____ stated that she only had the firearm down by her side and demonstrated to Deputy Woodin how she _____ the gun. _____ stated that her husband was trying to de-escalate the situation and ended up taking the gun away from her and putting it away. When asked why _____ or anyone _____ did not report her mental health emergency, she stated she _____ that it would make things worse and that due to her OCD, the rooms at the receiving facilities are dirty and she is very particular.

_____ was asked about how many guns are inside the home, she stated there are two. One of which is kept inside their vehicle, and the other is kept high up on a _____. She was not aware of what kind they are, only that they are handguns.

Deputy Woodin spoke to _____ about the incident with her son leaving. She stated that there was an argument between her and _____ due to rules he did not like. She went in to check on him and noticed him missing, which prompted her to call for law enforcement assistance. When asked about the cameras inside the home, _____ stated that it is to protect her from unnecessary allegations about multiple things, including abuse allegations against _____. She also stated it is to monitor her mother who lives with her who is _____ and has multiple health issues, including falls.

While conducting his investigation, _____ had an _____ medical emergency

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and was subsequently transported to the hospital by Volusia County EMS.

Based on his investigation, Deputy Woodin determined that there is no probable cause to arrest [REDACTED] for aggravated assault. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have been married for [REDACTED] 18 years and have multiple children together, making this a domestic violence incident. Due to no one claiming to be a victim, no Marsy's Law form was signed, and no lethality assessment was completed. Due to the extended time lapse of this incident, [REDACTED] did not exhibit any signs of a mental health crisis at the time of her interview with Deputy Woodin and she did not meet Baker Act criteria.

Based on [REDACTED] admitting to possessing a handgun and having readily access to other firearms inside the home, Deputy Woodin completed this report to assist in filing for a risk protection order against her. This report was also forward to DCF for their review based on [REDACTED] being present for the argument with the firearm. A copy was forward to Director Quann.

Case Status: Closed.
