He advised that he wished to speak to _____ for 10 minutes. _____ told _____ he could have the 10 minutes, but not alone with _____. _____ and _____ were in the garage. _____ stood away while _____ and _____ spoke. _____ asked if he could speak with _____ for just a few minutes alone. _____ went inside the house but left the door open so he could hear what was going on. _____ yelled. _____ came back into the garage and observed _____ pointing a gun at _____. _____ then pointed the gun at _____. _____ told _____ not to move, and that he did not wish to hurt him. _____ then pointed the gun at himself. _____ made it back inside the house. _____ asked _____ to put the gun down. _____ walked back and forth down the driveway and stated that _____ would not let him leave. _____ told _____ to get in his car and go. _____ then closed the garage and secured himself inside his home. While Caitlin was inside, she called 911. Approximately 60 seconds after _____ closed the garage, he heard a gunshot from outside. _____ stated he was fearful that _____ would shoot both him and _____. _____ and _____ waited inside until the arrival of law enforcement.

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[REDACTED] completed a sworn written statement indicating he wished to pursue criminal charges.

Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] advised that the handgun used by [REDACTED] was black and gold colored. [REDACTED] stated that it was a 9mm handgun.

While responding to the scene, Deputy Vargas located [REDACTED]'s vehicle (a [REDACTED] [REDACTED]) travelling in the 3700 block of Old Dixie Highway, Ormond Beach. A high-risk traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle, and [REDACTED] was detained.

Sergeant Blum read [REDACTED] his Warnings of Constitutional Rights from his Volusia Sheriff's Office Warnings of Constitutional Rights card. [REDACTED] advised he understood his rights and waived his right to Counsel. Post Warning of Constitutional Rights, [REDACTED] stated he was at his father-in-law's residence to collect belongings. [REDACTED] stated he was only provided with half of his property. [REDACTED] then stated he was done speaking with law enforcement. Sergeant Blum informed [REDACTED] of the allegations made against him and he denied all the allegations.

Deputies observed a semi-automatic handgun on the passenger seat of [REDACTED]'s vehicle. The handgun was a 9mm Glock semi-automatic handgun with a gold-colored slide (S/N AKVD696). The handgun had 10 rounds in the magazine, with 1 in the chamber.

Based on the above, Deputy Hinson determined that probable cause exists to criminally charge [REDACTED] with 2 counts of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. [REDACTED] was later transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail.

Deputies collected the handgun and ammunition, which were later submitted to evidence.
[REDACTED]'s vehicle was towed from the scene by Arrow Towing.

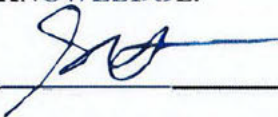
